HSD Parent Portal

Stay connected and informed. The HSD Parent Portal is a communications tool designed to enhance and increase parent/guardian involvement in the education of their children. The portal will provide secure online access to their child's student information. With a single username and password, you will be able to access the following data for each of your children attending an HSD school:

- Attendance Information
- Permissions & Consent Forms
- School Information

Before creating a Parent Access Account, you will first need to obtain a unique Access ID for each student profile that you want added to your account. Please contact our school office to request account setup information.

In past years, our school-wide fundraising money was used to install glass backboards in the gym, have partnered with the PAC to install a concrete pad outside, have improved our sound system in the music room and the lighting for our various concerts. This year we intend to continue our support our Phys. Ed., Guitar & Art programs, make further improvements to our front entrance and continue to improve the technology in each of our classrooms. We also will use some of the money to subsidize field trips and learning opportunities that are above and beyond the regular classroom routine.

The Lines of Communication

In an effort to keep track of our students' whereabouts, we ask that parents/guardians continue to communicate with the main office. Here are a few points to keep in mind:

- Please call between 8:30 and 8:50am to speak to someone directly, leave a message at anytime, email blumenort.hsd.ca to advise the office that your child will be absent or late, or log onto the **Parent Portal and put in an absent request!**
- If there is an unexplained student absence, we will continue the practice of calling parents after 9:00am and 1:00pm.
- If your children are leaving the building (for appointments or special outings, because of illness, etc.) during the course of the day, we ask that you and/or your children report to the office before departing.
- If your child arrives at school outside the regular times (appointment or illness, returning the same day after having checked out etc.), please make sure that the office knows about their arrival and also to pick up a late slip.

School Safety

Now that classes are about to start, we again need to pay close attention to the safety concerns that arise at the front of the school. We all need to cooperate and follow some basic rules to ensure that we keep our children safe.

- As you will see, there have been a few changes to the area in front of our school. The first is a fence to keep our students safe as they cross our bus loop. We ask that our students use either of the two openings in the fence to cross with the assistance of our student patrols. The second is a brand new sidewalk on the east side of School Blvd thanks to our municipality. From what we see, this will eliminate the need for our student patrols to cross our students at the former crosswalk. These two improvements will mean an update to our student movement plan so please stay tuned for that in the weeks ahead.
- Please remember that private vehicles need to avoid using our bus loop. After school however, once the busses have left, our bus loop will be available for student pickup. We ask that our students and our drivers are aware of the increased traffic in such a small area and to be cautious as you enter and leave.
- If for some reason you should happen to end up in the bus loop at the same time as buses are there, do not pass buses when stop signs are out and the lights are flashing (signaling loading and unloading).
- In front of our school there are a number of areas highlighted with bright yellow paint. Please avoid stopping or parking in these areas, as per the signs that are posted.
- At our main crosswalk on the 311, we ask for your same patience and awareness as our students make their way to and from school.
- Bike riders, walkers and those who are being picked up or dropped off always need to be aware of their surroundings. It is best to avoid the bus loop when possible and always remember to use care and caution.
- Once again this year, a second bike rack zone for students is located by the west main entrance. Students coming from the south and west on Park Street will now need to park in this area.
- Finally, we would like to remind all parents, relatives and visitors to please check in at the main office when you arrive at our school. From there we will be able to help you with your concerns.

Strong Connections - September 14th & 17th

The Strong Connections program is planned for our school on Friday, September 14th and Monday, September 17th. Strong Connections is a form of authentic assessment in a practical and useful way. The purpose is to enhance the beginning of the year classroom assessment for all children. It includes observation and assessment practices both in the classroom and on an individual basis.

Students will be asked to attend either on the Friday or the Monday, which was noted on the June Report Card. With half of our students present, students will then be further divided to allow our homeroom teachers the opportunity to meet one-on-one with each student and participate in assessment activities in Language Arts and Mathematics. This is an opportunity for teachers to gather data about each child's learning that may not be evident during whole class instruction. It is also an opportunity to further develop the teacher-student relationship to strengthen the connection.

A letter will be coming home shortly with the date that your child will attend or check the parent portal to view your dates. If you have any questions, please feel free to call our school.

Notice - Religious Exercises - Blumenort School - 2018-2019

The Board of Trustees of the Hanover School Division has received petitions requesting that religious exercises be held in Blumenort School during the 2018-2019 school year.

The petitioners have specified their desire for the recitation of the Lord's Prayer and the reading of a Bible passage or story from the Bible.

As the petitions bear the signatures of parents representing more than 60 students in the school, the Board of Trustees of the Hanover School Division has authorized religious exercises, as specified above, to be held before the official instructional day, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:05 a.m., in a designated common area of the school.

Provincial and divisional guidelines will be followed. These guidelines are available from the school office, the divisional administration offices, or on the web site at www.hsd.ca.

Only children of parents who have signed or joined the petition may participate. Parents may join the petition by forwarding a signed note to the Board of Trustees of the Hanover School Division, indicating the name and the grade of the students they are signing for.

Notice - Religious Instruction - Blumenort School - 2018-2019

The Board of Trustees of the Hanover School Division has received petitions requesting that religious instruction be held in Blumenort School during the 2018-2019 school year.

The petitioners have specified their desire for the Discovery Time program offered by Child Evangelism Fellowship.

As the petitions bear the signatures of parents representing more than 25 students in the school, the Board of Trustees of the Hanover School Division has passed the required by-law permitting religious instruction, as specified above, to be offered by volunteers during designated half-hour per week classes.
