# Poster Contest Rules and Prize Information

#### RULES:

- Posters must be drawn on an 8 1/2 X 11 inch letter sized paper, <u>1 entry</u> per student.
- Poster artwork may represent any Burn Awareness Week program fire safety subject.
- The contest is open to any student residing in Manitoba from grade 5 through to grade 8. Students can participate on their own without the participation of the school.
- Posters <u>MUST INCLUDE</u> the artists' name, grade, school & address on the <u>BACK</u> of the poster.

#### (Many posters are disqualified each year as they are submitted with no information.)

• Winning posters are based on age-appropriate skill, and will be judged on the message and content.

Judges decisions are final. Judges include representatives from the Office of the Fire Commissioner, Manitoba Firefighters Burn Fund, Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Services, and the Provincial Public Education committee.

#### PRIZES:

Prizes are awarded to four students (One winner from each of grade) throughout the province of Manitoba. All selected posters will be displayed on the Office of the Fire Commissioner and the Manitoba Firefighters Burn Fund website.

Grand Prize Winners will receive a **cash prize** for their school from the Manitoba Firefighters Burn Fund, a **\$200.00 Lego Store Gift card** for themselves and **safety materials** for their classmates. The winners poster will be highlighted on the Office of the Fire Commissioner and Burn Fund websites, as well as being used in promotional material where appropriate. The winner will also receive a recognition certificate to acknowledge their contribution to burn awareness.

#### All entries must be postmarked by no later than April 3, 2020


