#### Scheduling Changes for 2025-2026

As shared last week, this September we will be making a few changes to our schedule as we continue to find ways of engaging our students. More information will be shared as we get closer to the end of the year, but here is an overview for now.

- Tech Ed. Our Grade 7&8 students will be returning to Tech Ed. classes at Mitchell Middle School in September. Tech Ed. takes place for 4 periods, once a cycle.
- French Our Grade 5-8 French will now be offered every other day. Currently, it is offered everyday.
- Music Our Grade 7&8 Band Program will continue to be an option. Currently, those not in Band will take Music. In the fall, we will have a different option for them and that will be announced later.
- Red Rock Our Grade 7&8 students have headed to Red Rock Bible Camp every two years and this fall was to be the next scheduled visit. Rather than go on a three-day/two-night event, we will be organizing a couple of day trips in its place and avoid the extra fundraising and everything else associated with taking that many students away for that long a period.

# <u> The Umbrella Project - Dr. Jen</u>

**Create a set of family values.** What are your family values? Can your child discuss and defend them? Having a set of family values has a huge impact on the well-being of our children. It helps them to feel part of something bigger than themselves and identify healthy ways to behave and build their self-esteem. It also creates a set of guidelines that we can align our actions with to build and sustain integrity of thought and action, creating meaning and purpose in our lives. Living with purpose and feeling strong doesn't have to be about achieving specific goals. How we show up everyday for our friends, colleagues and family can make us feel that we are living purposefully every day.

Start by brainstorming as a family all of the experiences and values that are most important to you. This exercise should be done as a family so that everyone has a say in creating and sharing what matters most to them. Discuss each point that comes up and why it is important to the person who suggested it and to the larger group. Select the values that define your family and display them somewhere you can see them often.

When your child displays these values, try to notice and point them out to your child. Here are some of the ideas that came up in my family: generosity, honesty, sharing experiences and travel to broaden our minds, friendship, connecting with nature, giving back, a family that supports each other.
