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#### **Planning Priority #1**

By June 2025, our students will develop an age appropriate understanding of the relationship between their emotions and behaviours and how it affects their learning.

##### **Year-End Accomplishments**

- We worked our way through Year 4 of the Umbrella Project, a teacher-led curriculum and school based program created to help teachers, students and parents reframe our perception of challenges and strengthen the skills of well-being to positively cope with the everyday stresses of life.

#### **Planning Priority #2A**

By June 2025, all Grade 1-5 students will be meeting end-of-year expectations in Reading.

##### **Year-End Accomplishments**

- 71% of our students are reading at or above grade-level.

#### **Planning Priority #2B**

By June 2025, all Grade 6-8 students will be meeting end-of-year expectations in Writing.

##### **Year-End Accomplishments**

- 68% of our students achieved a 3 or a 4 on the provincial report card in Writing.

#### **Planning Priority #3**

By June 2025, all Grade 1-8 students will be meeting end-of-year expectations in Problem Solving.

##### **Year-End Accomplishments**

- 77% of our students achieved a 3 or a 4 on the provincial report card in Problem Solving.

- We completed our final year of the Middle Years Learning Opportunities program for our Grade 7&8 students.
