#### The Umbrella Project & The Seven Grandfather Teachings

Since September of 2021, we have held monthly assemblies that have focused on the eighteen social-emotional skills of The Umbrella Project. At the same time, as a staff and community we have been working to improve our focus on Indigenous Education. This year, something new! Our plan is to connect where possible, our monthly Umbrella Skills to the Seven Grandfather Teachings, which are as follows...wisdom, love, respect, bravery, honesty, humility, and truth. These are core Indigenous values that provide guidance for living a good life and are often represented by specific animals, such as the beaver for wisdom or the bear for bravery. The teachings are meant to be used together, as one cannot have wisdom without all the other virtues. In the month of November, we will connect Growth Mindset and Wisdom. Developing a growth mindset means that we are willing to learn from our mistakes. It takes wisdom to be able to reflect on what we tried, and to think about what we can try next. Incorporating a growth mindset with wisdom means that we don't just strive to improve, but we also reflect on how and why we improve, adjusting our actions based on experience. # Parent Parking, Drop-Offs and Pick-Ups at Blumenort School

With the seasons changing, now is a good time for a reminder about how we address the safety concerns that arise in front of our school. We all need to cooperate and follow some basic rules to ensure that we keep our children safe. Here are two important reminders, specifically for those driving.

- 1. Avoid dropping off/picking up your little ones on the west side of School Blvd.
  - The School Blvd Park Road Intersection can be extremely busy and having our students cross unaccompanied to head into school or meet their ride is very concerning for many reasons.
  - A reminder that parent vehicles will need to use the east side of School Blvd or the front parking lot instead.
  - If spots are not available, feel free to make another loop and good chance a spot will open up for you to park.
- 2. Avoid stopping/parking in areas highlighted with bright yellow paint or with pylons.
  - These areas are clearly marked with signage for a reason.
  - When one stops/parks where they shouldn't, it creates an unnecessary backlog of vehicles.
