Kindergarten Registration for the 2026-2027 School Year

Kindergarten Registration for the 2026-2027 school year is now open. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to register their children in January for September entry, as this will assist schools in planning and scheduling. Early registration also provides the opportunity to participate in upcoming orientation events in spring. To be eligible for September registration (2026-2027 school year), children must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2026. Students are required to attend the school within the catchment area where they reside, which ensures balanced enrollment across the division. Nobody's Perfect Parenting Program

Steinbach Family Resource Centre is excited to share that our next Nobody's Perfect Parenting Session will be beginning soon.

Program Details:

When: Thursday's from 1:00–3:00 PM; Starting March 19

Where: Steinbach Family Resource Centre, 101 North Front Drive, Steinbach MB

What: 6-week course (attendance is required at all 6 sessions)

What is Nobody's Perfect?

Nobody's Perfect is a supportive and welcoming program for parents and caregivers of children ages 0–5. It offers an opportunity to connect with others and discuss personal challenges and experiences in parenting. Participants learn about their child's feelings, behaviors, body, and safety while sharing and growing together. Childcare is provided as needed.

Participants can expect:

- A chance to meet new people with similar interests and concerns
- Free, interactive, and engaging sessions
- Positive parenting techniques
- Increased understanding of children's health, safety, and behaviour
- Opportunities to build on existing skills and learn new ones
- Improved self-esteem and coping skills
- Increased self-help and mutual support
- Connections to community services and resources

Participants also choose the topics for discussion, ensuring the sessions are meaningful and relevant to their specific needs.

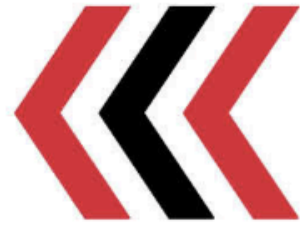
Research shows that participants in the Nobody's Perfect Parenting Program experience increased:

- Confidence in their parenting skills
- Ability to cope with stress
- Problem-solving skills
- Resiliency
- Self-sufficiency and independence
- Positive parent-child interactions
- Use of positive discipline techniques
- Access to peer, social, and community support
